
October 25, 2012 - Dining Out at Aubri Lane's Restaurant


MBCA Fast Facts

Subject: Mercedes Benz Fuel Distribution

I am having a problem with my 1986 300E - the car runs fine, then suddenly looses power for a few seconds, than all is well again. It runs fine full throttle. It has stalled when parking, or going around a corner, then restarts quickly. It has been at times very hard to start, runs rough for a few seconds, then OK. The car occasionally hesitates on initial acceleration. I have replaced spark plugs, distributor cap and rotor, spark plug wires and fuel pressure accumulator — all to no avail.

First make sure your ignition system is in good condition – have it checked on an ignition analyzer to make sure all ignition components are working well. This symptom is common in high mileage gasoline models with the CIS-E fuel injection system. I have solved it several times by replacing the O ring under the fuel distributor. The part number is 004 997 06 48

Evidence of the leaking "O" ring is raw fuel present in the intake manifold after the car sits overnight. With the engine stopped, take off the air cleaner and press and hold down the air flow sensor, the big plate in the air intake, and look for fuel present down in the manifold. If you see wetness then that is likely the cause.

Another cause of rough engine operation is leakage from the EHA (electro- hydraulic actuator). The EHA is that small black box mounted on the side of the fuel distributor. It has a two-wire electrical connector. The EHA reacts to signals from the engine computer to adjust fuel control pressure in the fuel distributor.

If the EHA itself is leaking fuel, it must be replaced. But there are two small green O rings (See Figure below) that seal the EHA to the side of the fuel distributor. If these O rings are leaking, you may experience rough operation or stalling. Close inspection of the EHA can determine if these O rings are leaking. They are available as part # 000 070 39 62 which includes two new attaching screws.






